We are introducing the Society for Neuro-Oncology (SNO) Community Neuro-Oncology Committee, which was formed last year to recognize that the majority of some form of neuro-oncology care is provided in the community. There is an unmet need to not only create or strengthen the relationships between practitioners caring for patients with brain and spine tumors in the community and their respective tertiary/quaternary academic institutions but also to support these community providers to offer best practice neuro-oncology care in the community. We are taking the first steps of formally recognizing our community practitioners who care for patients with brain and spine tumors by trying to compile a directory of who is practicing neuro-oncology in the community, whether by training versus happenstance. The benefits that the Society for Neuro-Oncology would like to bring to the community practitioners are to offer increased opportunities for engagement with tertiary/quaternary institutions, provide networking opportunities amongst community practitioners, and disseminate practice guidelines for the care of patients with brain and spine tumors.
